Tryouts for the 2019-2020 cheer squad will be held in the gym on Friday, May 17, at 3:15 pm.

Only students registered to attend St. Viator School for the 2019-2020 school year qualify to participate in the tryouts. Signatures from a parent and an administrator are required at the bottom of this page to validate student registration. This form must accompany the medical form and the diocesan form designated below.

Clinics to teach the tryout cheer and dance will be held in the gym on Tuesday, May 14, and Wednesday, May 15, from 3:00 to 4:30 pm. All girls will need to fill out and turn this form along with Diocesan Athletic Consent Form to be able to participate in the clinics and tryouts. The forms are to be turned in to the cheer moderator on May 14, prior to being allowed to participate. **Failure to turn in all the necessary forms will result in being disqualified from attending the clinics and tryouts.**

The purpose of cheerleading is to promote school spirit and unity among students, staff, athletes, and activity groups. Cheerleaders will represent St. Viator School by participating in school functions, fostering enthusiasm at school sporting events, assemblies, competitions, and other school related functions. In addition, performances can be included for community and charity events.

Cheerleading is a year-long commitment that involves travel to various locations, practices, and approximately \$350 for uniform purchase, which includes dress, shoes, socks, cheer undergarments, and ribbons. Payment will be due July, 2019. Full uniform is required at every game, and so are Christian attitudes and actions. An incomplete uniform results in being benched and not being able to perform with the squad for that game or event. Each cheerleader is responsible for getting herself to and from games and practices promptly.

Please do not try out if you are already involved in other activities that would spread you too thin and prevent you from fulfilling your cheer commitments and let your squad down. You would also be taking up a spot that another girl would have appreciated. We will have some practices in the summer months, and when the school year begins, practices are twice a week, from 3:00 to 4:00 pm. Some Saturday practices will also be necessary to learn dances. Missed practices for any reason will result in being unable to join the squad at the next performance.

If you are in 4th, 5th, 6th, or 7th grade, energetic, fun, love to perform and dance, and you think you can abide by these rules while maintaining good grades, we invite you to try out for the St. Viator School cheerleading squad. JV is 5th and 6th grade, and Varsity is 7th and 8th grade.
