RULES

Sportsmanship, Etiquette and Goals:

To follow all Chess Club rules and behavior expectations of St. Viator Chess Club as detailed below.

- A. If a student does not want to play chess upon arrival, they must immediately move to Morning Care (Morning Care fees will apply).
- B. Students are expected to participate fully and daily if they come to Chess Club.
- C. Play by the rules: touch move, not touching your opponent's pieces, not forfeiting mid game for any reason, respecting your opponent, and displaying good sportsmanship at all times.
- D. To be respectful of all coaches and moderators and to listen and follow their directions.
- E. Must be willing to play against anyone in the club.
- F. To understand chess is a quiet game, no talking during a game. Students need time to think time and therefore talking must be soft and only when appropriate (no screaming, no calling out).
- G. You may address your opponent during the game only to offer a draw or state check or checkmate.
- H. Avoid distracting your opponent or pressuring your opponent to make a move.
- I. No alternate games, toys, books, cell phones or electronic devices are permitted.
- J. Treat chess pieces and boards with respect (no flipping the table or turning the board over).
- K. Stand and organize the pieces on the side of the board when captured.
- L. After each game, reset the pieces on the board to ready for play.
