## ➤ Public Libraries

Download the Libby App and connect to your local library using your library card from the public library. Follow the sign up instructions. You can then check out books and renew them on line. You can read books on your phone, computer, tablet, or kindle.

## ➤ Check for the AR Level and availability of an AR Test
