VZV, Varicella (Chickenpox)	Dose 1: 12 to 18 months Dose 2: 4 years old	2
PreK and/or Kindergarten Students Also Need:		
Haemophilus influenzae type b conjugate vaccine (Hib)	Dose 1: 2 months Dose 2: 4 months Dose 3: 6 months Dose 4: 12 to 18 months	4
Pneumococcal (Prevnar, PCV7, PCV13)	Dose 1: 2 months Dose 2: 4 months Dose 3: 6 months Dose 4: 12 to 18 months	4

- All students entering Pre-K and Kindergarten must have received all required vaccines at the youngest recommended age per the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP).
- All students entering 7th grade must receive a Tdap Booster vaccine and Neisseria meningitides (meningitis) in the form of a quadrivalent meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4).
- All students new to the state of Nevada must have received the Hepatitis A series.
