First Day of School for Pre-K through 8th: Mon., Aug. 12th:

- Grades 4-8 classroom doors open at 7:35 am (bell rings at 7:45am)

*All parents welcome to campus for classroom drop-off,

Dismissal at 11:50am, all 4-8 students will be dismissed in the loop for pick up

- Grades PK-3 classroom doors open at 7:45 am (bell rings at 8:00 am)

*All parents welcome to campus for classroom drop-off, grades 2-3 loop available for drop-off only. Dismissal at 12:00 pm from classrooms ~ No loop for pick up

- All students wear their casual uniform
- All students bring all purchased supplies with them
- All students bring backpacks with them
- Students in grades PK should bring a lunch
- Kinder, 1st, 2nd should bring a snack
- Extended care is available on the first day (students will need a lunch)

NEW CELL PHONE POLICY: Students must exit cars and arrive outside of the gate with their cell phones already turned off and inside their backpacks. Cell phones MAY NOT be accessed, used, or visible anywhere on campus (inside & outside of the school gates.)

Dismissal at 11:50am, all 4-8 students will be dismissed in the loop for pick up

- Grades PK-3 classroom doors open at 7:45 am (bell rings at 8:00 am)

*All parents welcome to campus for classroom drop-off, grades 2-3 only - loop is available for drop off. Dismissal at 12:00 pm from classrooms ~ No loop for pick up

- All students wear their casual uniform on Tuesday and Wednesday
- All students bring backpacks with them
- Students in grades PK should bring a lunch
- Kinder, 1st, 2nd should bring a snack
- Extended care is available on Tuesday and Wednesday (students will need a lunch)
- On Thurs. Aug 15 **all students wear their Dress uniform** for Mass. Mass K-8 @ 8:15 am (Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary) parents are invited to join us
- Extended care is NOT AVAILABLE ON THURSDAY 8/16 (All faculty and staff have a mandatory Safety PD presented by the Director of Security for the ADOLV. School Office will also close at 12:15pm)

Regular School Day: Fri., Aug. 16th:

- Grades 4-8 classroom doors open at 7:35 am (bell rings at 7:45am)

Parents may use the loop for drop off. Dismissal at 2:35pm, all 4-8 students will be dismissed in the loop for pick-up

- Grades PK-3 classroom doors open at 7:45 am (bell rings at 8:00 am) Dismissal at 2:45pm from the classroom.

*Parents of students in grades PK-1 must park in the church lot and walk their students to the East School Gate. Parents of students in grades 2-3 may use the East loop for drop-off. Dismissal at 2:45pm for grades PK-3 at classroom doors. There is no pick-up from the loop for grades PK-3.
